These two public meetings are part of a brainstorming session (known as a “Charrette” in the Design field) in which a Design Team will work for three days to finalize plans for improvement. These public meetings are planned in order to involve the community in the “Safe Routes to School Plan” that your school’s PTA, in coordination with the school and the City of Fort Worth, are creating. The Design Team needs your help in creating the final proposals which will be based on input from our parent survey and input at these two meetings.

The PTA’s of Park Glen Elementary, Parkwood Hill Intermediate, and Hillwood Middle Schools have been working together in creating their individual Safe Routes to School Plans because of the close proximity to one another and the feeder patterns of the schools. Therefore, this is a joint meeting of parents and students of all three schools, as well as any other interested parties such as property owners and businesses.

The purpose of the Safe Routes to School Plan is to create safer routes for our children to and from school and to promote a healthy lifestyle in our children by encouraging them to get out and exercise, i.e. walking and bicycling around the community.
