

CHEETAH SUPERSTARS MATH

A PTA SPONSORED PROGRAM

☆ We will be starting Cheetah Superstar Math on October the 5th. In previous years, the programs was only available for grades 1st through 4th. This year, we're proud to announce that Kindergarten is now included. ☆

For those of you new to Park Glen Elementary, CHEETAH SUPERSTARS MATH is a supplemental math program for children that provides fun, yet challenging, math problems to help encourage thinking skills and reinforce classroom math lessons. This is a **VOLUNTARY** program that is now open to all grade students, K through 4th.

Students are able to earn up to 20 points for each sheet :18 for math problems and 2 for their full name and their teacher's name (Kindergartners can earn 4 points for their full name and teacher's name). A perfect score on each of the 16 sheets will earn the student 320 points. In addition, there is a chance to earn an extra five points for completing a survey at the end of the program (for a possible total of 325 points). Students earning at least 270 points will receive one of three CHEETAH SUPERSTARS MATH Trophies at the end-of-the-year school Awards Program. There will also be prizes awarded throughout the year when students earn the following point totals:

150 Points	Personal STAR on the Wall	285 Points	Shinning Star Trophy *

* Students will receive one trophy (highest earned)			

In addition, each week randomly selected participating students from each grade level will receive a coupon for a free children's meal at one of our local restaurants.

PROCEDURAL CHANGES

In order to allow the children more time to complete the worksheets:

- ☆ • The worksheets will be available online the Friday before each week on the Park Glen PTA website (<http://www.parkglenpta.org/>) AND
- A hard copy will be available at the CHEETAH SUPERSTARS MATH table (near the gym in the main hallway) starting Monday and throughout the week.

Upon completion of the worksheet:

- The worksheet is to be placed into a special box on the CHEETAH SUPERSTARS MATH table.
- Sheets may be turned in anytime during the week beginning on Monday morning at 7:50 a.m. until **Friday at 8:30 a.m.** (The CM box will be removed from the table at 8:30 a.m. on Friday.)
- Worksheets are to be inserted into the grade-level slot in the CM box. **Therefore, it is imperative that your child's name and the teacher's name be on the sheet in order to receive proper credit.**

As always, worksheets are to be completed by the student **at home**. If the student does not read well, the problem may be read to them; however, **The students are to work the problems independently**. Parents may explain the nature of the problem and demonstrate a SIMILAR problem, but the actual problem is to be **completed by the student**. Parents are also encouraged to review the worksheets for correctness upon the student's completion and allow the student the opportunity to re-work any problems they may have incorrectly solved.

As in the past, the scores will be posted by class on the CHEETAH SUPERSTARS MATH wall (near the gym in the main hallway) by the Wednesday following the Friday due date. Graded sheets will be sent home in the student's take-home folder. If you feel an error has been made in the grading of a worksheet, please use the "Cheetah Math Request Form" located at the Cheetah Math Table or available online. Complete the form and attach worksheet (if necessary) and place in the Cheetah Math box for further review. **Please note that you should complete this form and turn it in within two weeks of that worksheet's due date (see above). After that time, all scores will remain as posted.**

As before, participation in CHEETAH SUPERSTARS MATH does not require a permanent commitment. If for some reason your child is unable to complete each worksheet, he or she may stop and restart the program at any time. But please encourage them to restart the program; because even though CHEETAH SUPERSTARS MATH is educational, above all it is **FUN!** And responses to past surveys indicate that it is a **HUGE** treat for the children to participate in this program and to possibly receive the end-of-the-year CHEETAH SUPERSTARS MATH Trophy or the top honor this year of Lunch with the Principal.
